

**Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy – Issue 3 (01-2019)****Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy Statement**

CR Civil Engineering Limited acknowledges the existence of the Modern Slavery Act and does not engage in the practices of modern slavery or human trafficking.

As a small organisation we have taken no further steps or due diligence to check our supply chain and have not provided any human trafficking or slavery training to our staff as we feel this is not a reasonably foreseeable risk to our business.

Child Labour – the Company does not and will not engage in or support the use of child labour. If the Company engages any young workers (e.g. on work experience), it will ensure that a suitable risk assessment is carried out and that young persons are not exposed to any hazardous conditions, or in any case work more than 8 hours per day. The Company respects and supports children's rights consistent with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) and the Children's Rights and Business Principles (CRBP).
